- Place the well-being and safety of each player above all other considerations, including the development of their performance.
- Adhere to all guidelines & rules laid down by FC Comets.
- Please pay fees on time.
- Be punctual and reliable in attendance to training & matches.
- Develop a supportive relationship with both the coach and your child based on mutual trust and respect.
- Encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
- Co-operate fully with specialists (e.g. other coaches, officials, doctors, and physiotherapists) in the interest of your son/daughter.
- Always promote the positive aspects of football (e.g. fair play) and never condone violations of the laws of the game, behaviour contrary to the spirit of the law
- Always display high standards of behaviour
- Emphasise the importance of striving to win, not winning itself.
- Praise effort and performance more than results.
- Support the club through supporting social events & fundraising initiatives.
- At training & matches follow the spectator's code of conduct.

- Make training & playing the game fun. 😊
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of each and every person and treat equally.
- Place the well-being and safety of each player above all other considerations, including the development of performance.
- Adhere to all guidelines laid down by FC Comets
- Develop an appropriate supportive relationship with each player based on mutual trust and respect.
- Encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
- Ensure that the activities you direct or advocate are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of players.
- Clarify with the player (and where appropriate with the parent), exactly what is expected of them and also what they are entitled to expect from their coach.
- Co-operate fully with specialists (e.g. other coaches, officials, doctors, physiotherapists) in the best interests of the player.
- Promote the appropriate code of conduct and positive aspects of football (e.g. fair play) to players, parents and spectators alike.
- Never condone violations of the laws of the game, behaviour contrary to the spirit of the laws of the game or relevant rules and regulations.
- Consistently display high standards of behaviour and be a role model for players, parents and spectators.
- Treat match officials & opposing teams as you would wish to be treated.
- Win with good grace and Lose with good grace.
- Play to win. Celebrate the game, not just the result.
- Wear the kit with pride.
- Recognise performance, commitment & attitude in equal measure.
- Ensure parents & spectators follow their codes.

- Adhere to all guidelines & rules laid down by FC Comets.
- Encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
- Always promote the positive aspects of football (e.g. fair play) and never condone violations of the laws of the game, behaviour contrary to the spirit of the laws of the game or relevant rules and regulations or the use of prohibited substances or techniques.
- Always display high standards of behaviour.
